**RESPONSE OF CTIA TO CENTRAL MAINE POWER
REQUEST FOR CLARIFICATION**

CTIA hereby responds to the Request for Clarification filed by Central Maine Power in the present docket on November 25, 2019 (the “Request”) regarding the Maine Public Utilities Commission’s (“Commission’s”) November 6, 2019 Order (“Order”) regarding amendments to the Commission’s pole attachment rules.

While CTIA does not agree that the Order is ambiguous, it does not oppose the Commission further clarifying that the FCC “cable rate” formula applies to telecommunications attachments in Maine, including wireless attachments. CTIA has no comment on the Request’s stance on attachments by electric utilities.
